What are CLTs?

A **CLT** is formed by a group of local people working together to create affordable homes for their community.



Long-term affordability

CLTs act as long-term stewards of housing, ensuring that it remains genuinely affordable for local people.



Urban and rural impact

CLTs are established in towns, cities and rural villages meeting local housing needs across the country.



Community at the heart

Giving local people a real say in how homes and spaces are built and used to truly reflect local community needs.

Homes powered by local people



Chagford CLT, Devon

Type: Section 106

Bellacouch Meadows, consists of 28 affordable homes, a mix of affordable rent and shared ownership. It's the first Section 106 **CLT** scheme to be completed in the UK and the largest development in the history of Dartmoor National Park.

Toller Porcorum CLT, Dorset

Type: Land-led

This **CLT** was set up to create sustainable community assets, including affordable homes and a local post office.

The homes we delivered – one flat and five houses – are all for affordable rent. The development also provides the village post office with a permanent new home, securing its future at the heart of the community.



Nailsworth CLT, Gloucestershire

Type: Land-led

Built on former garages previously owned by Stroud District Council, we have provided ten affordable homes for affordable rent. They were driven by local need and shaped by the community from the start. The planning permission was granted through a Community Right to Build Order, following a public vote.

Arundel CLT, West Sussex

27 new energy-efficient, affordable homes exclusively for local people with a strong connection to the area. The biggest increase in affordable housing in Arundel in the last 35 years. Find out more [**here**](#).



Transition Homes CLT (Dartington), Devon

39 new energy-efficient (EPC A) affordable homes, all for social rent for local residents with a strong connection to Dartington and the adjacent parishes. Our largest CLT scheme to date. Find out more [**here**](#).

21 new thoughtfully designed homes for social rent are planned to be available to local residents with a connection to the parish.



Chawleigh CLT, Devon

Ten new homes for social rent. The six two-bedroom houses, two three-bedroom houses and two one-bedroom flats will be for local residents or those with a strong connection to the village.
